

Graduate Discounts

From 2018, Faculty of Education graduates who go on to study for a postgraduate award delivered by the Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) or further study of an RAD award can benefit from a 10% reduction in tuition fees.

The 10% discount is available for students who start their programme of study on or after 1 August 2018 and will be applied to their tuition fees for the full duration of the programme.

Students do not need to apply for the discount. If a student is eligible, the discount will be applied automatically to their tuition fee invoice.

To be eligible for a discount, students must:

- be progressing within **five** years of graduation:
 - **either** from the final year of an undergraduate programme to a PGCE and/or Master's programme;
 - **or** from an RAD certificate award to a diploma and/or to a full degree.

The following exclusions apply:

- Applications where a student's start date is more than five years after they graduated will not be eligible for a discount.

Eligible programmes:

- BA (Hons) Dance Education
- Diploma of Higher Education: Dance Education
- Certificate of Higher Education: Dance Education
- Diploma in Dance Teaching Studies
- Postgraduate Certificate in Education: Dance Teaching (with Qualified Teacher Status)
- Master of Arts in Education (Dance Teaching)
- Postgraduate Diploma in Education (Dance Teaching)
- Postgraduate Certificate in Education (Dance Teaching)

Non-eligible programmes:

- BA (Hons) Ballet Education
- Certificate in Ballet Teaching Studies
- Licentiate of the Royal Academy of Dance
- Professional Dancers' Teaching Diploma
- Professional Dancers' Postgraduate Teaching Certificate

How do I receive my graduate discount? For the reduced tuition fee, you need to be accepted on your intended programme of study and be able to satisfy all the normal admissions criteria. You also need to meet the RAD's enrolment and registration conditions.
