### 19<sup>th</sup> Century Variations

If candidates choose a 19<sup>th</sup> century variation from the above list, the variation must be taken from a traditional classical 19<sup>th</sup> century production. Versions must be rooted in classical 19<sup>th</sup> century vocabulary - contemporary interpretations using 20<sup>th</sup> or 21<sup>st</sup> century choreography will not be accepted. Candidates will be asked on application to identify which company and production their chosen 19<sup>th</sup> century variation is from.

### 20<sup>th</sup> Century Variations
