

Membership Terms & Conditions

1. RAD membership runs from 1 September to 31 August, with subscriptions paid annually in advance. Your membership is for a minimum period of 12 months unless you join partway through a year.
2. By becoming a member, you agree that you will adhere to the [RAD Code of Conduct](#). Teaching members agree to follow the [Code of Professional Practice](#).
3. Your membership is continuous, unless revoked by the RAD in line with [membership disciplinary procedures](#).
4. As a new member, you will have a 7-day cooling-off period in which you have the right to cancel your subscription. We will refund your payment within 30 days of cancellation. This will, however, incur a handling fee of 10%.
5. You must confirm in writing that you no longer wish to continue your membership.
6. If you cancel your membership, and re-apply in the future, you are subject to the eligibility criteria at the time of application. Any previous loyalty entitlements may not remain.
7. We reserve the right to reject an application for membership and do not have to disclose the reason(s) for doing so.
8. On receipt of your application we will take payment for the fee. However, our acceptance of your membership remains subject to approval. If we cannot accept your application we will confirm that your account has been re-credited (if applicable).
9. The eligibility criteria for applications to some membership categories is based on your most recent/highest RAD qualification.
10. We reserve the right to review and amend membership subscription fees. You will be informed of any change along with your renewal notification. Our website will also detail these fees and any other changes to your membership.
11. Teaching membership subscription fee payments not received within three months will incur an administration fee of £25/€38.
12. If you wish to change your membership category part-way through the year, you will be required to pay the difference (if the membership fee is higher). If the membership fee is lower, a part refund will not be given.
13. We hold your contact details securely to enable us to provide information on Royal Academy of Dance services, products and activities and that may be of interest to you. In providing us with this information, you give us permission to contact you in relation to these. We will not disclose your details to any third party without your express permission unless legally required to do so.
