CPD Requirement for New and Reinstating Teachers

As a teacher registered with the Royal Academy of Dance (RAD), you are required to complete a minimum of 20 hours Continuing Professional Development (CPD) each year in order to retain your teaching status. By participating in the RAD's CPD scheme you will be able to evidence that you are at the forefront of dance education and training, and that you have the most up-to-date knowledge and skills.

The CPD year runs from 1 September to 31 August each year. If you have joined part-way through a CPD year, the amount of CPD you are required to do will be reduced for your first year only, as per the table below:

| Month joined/re-joined | Minimum number of Time-Valued CPD hours to undertake | Maximum number of Independent CPD hours to undertake | CPD hours reduced by |
